Subjects

83% of pupils achieved a 4+ grade in the new grading system in English Language and 67% in the same system in Maths. 67% gained A*-C in two Sciences and 62% in at least one Foreign Language. 100% attained C+ in Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Music; in Geography 87%; DT 77%, English Literature 75% (of all pupils), Art 73%, Food Technology 70%. In Religious Studies 78% reached a C+ at GCSE.

Headline Figures:

67% of pupils gained 5 grades at C+.

58.7% gained 5 grades at C+/4+ including English and Maths.

35% achieved the English Baccalaureate of C+ in all of English, Maths, 2 Sciences, a Modern Foreign Language and either History or Geography.

Headteacher's summary: These results must be set against the national context which saw major changes to qualifications in Maths and the two English GCSEs and a new grading system. All the headlines in the national papers suggest a fall in the threshold figures but against this context we can be very pleased with the results above as bearing testimony to the hard work of pupils and staff. Of particular note are the continuing high performance in English, the Ebacc figure which remains high and the excellent performance in the subjects listed above.
