**Subjects:** 82% of pupils achieved Grades A\*-C in English and 74% in Maths. 76% of the year group gained A\*-C in two Sciences and 55% in at least one Foreign Language.

100% attained C+ in Biology, Chemistry and Physics; in Additional Science it was 93%, in History 90%, in English Literature 87% (of all pupils), in Art 85%, in Computing 82%, in Food Technology 80%, in PE and Drama 78%, in Geography and Music 75% and in German 66%. In Religious Studies 72% of the year group reached either C+ at GCSE or passed an AS Level.

**Headline Figures:** 78% of pupils gained 5 grades at C+. 68% gained 5 grades at C+ including English and Maths. 45% achieved the English Baccalaureate of C+ in all of English, Maths, two Sciences, a Modern Foreign Language and either History or Geography (+8%) – this is by some way our highest score since this started in 2010.

**Headteacher's summary:** This is a very good set of results across so many subjects. There are more A\* and A grades this year and many of them are in a very challenging set of subjects. The number of pupils achieving the English Baccalaureate is a great tribute to the attitude of the pupils in this year group and to the staff who taught them so well.
