### Subjects

There were 3 A\* grades in both Chemistry and Maths.

There were 7 A grades in English Literature, 6 in History, 5 in Religious Studies and 4 in Maths.

There were 100% A\*-B Grades in Design & Technology, Drama, German and Further Maths.

Big successes at A\*-C were Art (89%), English Literature (82%), Geography (79%), Government & Politics (77%), History (79%), Music and PE (100%), Religious Studies (93%), Sociology (77%). There were solid performances in other subjects, too: Biology (67%), Chemistry (69%), Physics (67%), Economics (68%), French (71%), Maths (63%) and Psychology (68%).

### Headline Figures

98% of all grades at E+

72% of all grades at C+

42% of all grades at B+

There were 124 students in this year group.

Average points per subject entry: 83 (*UCAS*), 214 (*Perf*)

Average points per student: 297 (*UCAS*), 755 (*Perf*)

**Headteacher's summary:** There were a lot of cheery faces on results morning and many students very happy with their university acceptance. At a time when A Levels are getting harder our results show a modest improvement. I am so impressed by those who gained a whole string of high grades. It is difficult for people to understand how much dedication that requires these days.

It is also my ambition that our students should do even greater things at A Level in the future, so we have great plans for a lively, well focused start with our new Year 12 in September.
