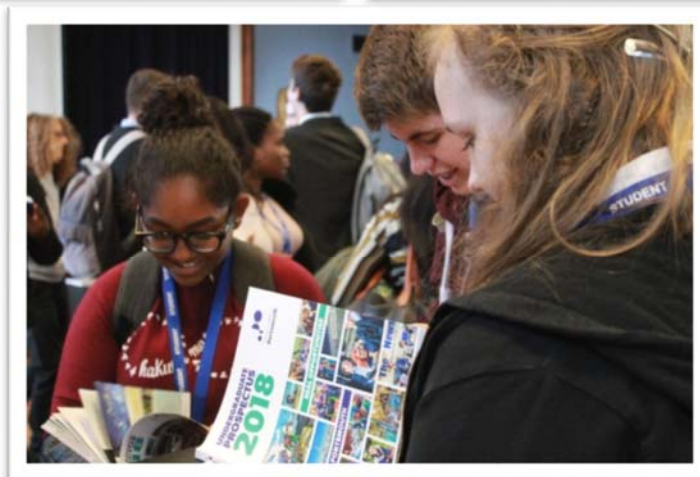
Friday 20th October – Staff Development Day – School closed to pupils and students.
