
Art Curriculum

- In Art you get to explore a wide range of topics and you will get the chance to use lots of different materials.
- In Year 7 we do a Portrait Project where you learn all the essential techniques using pencils.
- In Year 8 we look at Environments and in this project you get the chance to do
 a variety of printing, as well as learning one point perspective and also collage.
- In Year 9 we do a Human Rights Project, in this project we experiment with painting, stencils, and also, Art with a message. In Year 9 you also get the chance to take Photography as a subject.
- We take part in competitions in the local community, visit galleries and there are also times were pupils can take part in workshops.



What is great about Art at Tenison's?

- We are a small but friendly department with the aim to make pupils feel at home in the Art room. In our teaching we focus on giving the pupils the confidence to express themselves, as well as developing as young artists.
- We start with the basics of Art and each year build upon the skills previously learnt. We like to do lots of demonstrations and enjoy lots of group discussions in order to pick apart the work of Artist's and the meaning behind Artwork we are exploring. Pupils enjoy being in a practical subject and learning new skills.
